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## Lošinj – the island with more than 2600 sunshine hours per year

A unique geographical position at the intersection of the sea streams of Istria, Kvarner and Dalmatia makes the island of Lošinj an ideal destination for recreation and revitalisation, both for domestic and international tourists. Add to this the mild Mediterranean climate, the impeccable purity of the sea, untouched nature and abundant sunshine hours, it is no surprise that Lošinj has been a favourite tourist destination for 130 years, justifiably earning its reputation as the 'Island of Vitality'.



## Lošinj Hotels & Villas, part of Jadranka Group – the fifth largest tourism company in Croatia

Jadranka Group has successfully operated in the hospitality industry on the island of Lošinj for more than 70 years. Today, Jadranka is the fifth largest tourism company in Croatia, and the largest employer on the islands of Lošinj and Cres. Special attention is given to investing in human resources and continuing the education of its employees, as well as scholarships for students; Jadranka Group was declared the third best employer in the category of large companies according to the "Best Employer 2015" survey.





The company has around 800 permanent employees, rising to approximately 1,700 during the summer season across the group, including subsidiary companies Jadranka Tourism, Slatina Campsite, and Jadranka Yachting. The group also owns a local radio station, Radio Jadranka.

**Lošinj Hotels & Villas** is the hotel brand of Jadranka Tourism, which includes four- and five-star hotels, villas, suites and restaurants in some of the most attractive locations of the island of Lošinj, by the sea, surrounded by an Aleppo pine forest and close to sports facilities. In total, the portfolio can accommodate more than 3,500 guests.

### The investment cycle – repositioning and improving the offer

In 2007, Jadranka Group began a comprehensive investment cycle aimed at raising its accommodation categorisations to four- and five-star and repositioning the portfolio in the tourism market, including the reconstruction of hotel accommodation capacities. Having invested more than 170 million EUR over the last nine years, ambitious investment plans for the next three to four years include new promenade infrastructure in Čikat Bay to link Haračić park to the Lanterna restaurant; reconstruction of Hotel Helios and the surrounding villas; redevelopment and expansion of the Mali Lošinj Airport; construction of a new eco golf resort; and the realisation of a new marina project.

### Environmental protection

The policy of sustainable development and environmentally friendly operations are an important part of the corporate culture, as confirmed by the White Flag, obtained by **Hotel Bellevue** in August 2015, by **Boutique Hotel Alhambra** in October 2017, and since 2018 by **Vitality Hotel Punta's beach and Sunčana Bay**. The White Flag is an initiative started by Prince Albert II's Foundation and Global Under Water Awareness Association (GUWAA), and it represents an ecological symbol of clean water, at the same time raising global awareness on the issue of marine waste. Additionally, continued care for environmental protection and the use of renewable energy sources are proven by the trademark ZelEn – Friend of the nature, while HACCP certification is a guarantee of food safety and high standards of the entire process of procurement, processing and food service in the hotels Bellevue, Boutique Hotel Alhambra, Family Hotel Vespera, Hotel Aurora and Vitality Hotel Punta. The group is proud of the ISO 9001:2000 certificate for quality management; the ISO 9001:2015, which represents the most important revision of the ISO 9001:2000 standard; the ISO 14001:2004 certificate for environmental management; the ISO 14001:2015 – revision of the ISO 14001:2004 standard; and the ISO 50001:2018 for energy efficiency management.





## Development of five-star tourism – the exclusive Čikat Bay



After the reconstruction of Hotel Bellevue, Lošinj's first five-star hotel, which opened its doors to guests in July 2014, the first stage of the investment cycle in the exclusive Čikat Bay was successfully completed a year later. This is one of the most beautiful and intimate bays in the region, whose century-old Aleppo pine forest shelters Hotel Bellevue, Boutique Hotel Alhambra and the villas, Hortensia, Mirasol and Augusta. These hotels and villas offer guests the highest quality accommodation and customisation through their premium five-star level services, providing guests with a new dimension of vacation.

In addition to the above accommodation, Čikat Bay's promenade, waterfront, beach and the entire surroundings were restructured during the first stage, with particular attention paid to minimising environmental interventions. The lighting project in Čikat Bay was awarded the prestigious 'Lighting Design Award 2016' in the category for best lighting design of a public space.







## Hotel Bellevue

Hotel Bellevue, Lošinj's first five-star hotel, opened in July 2014, providing the first-rate design and service levels demanded by even the most discerning guests. During reconstruction, special care was taken to preserve the original concept and interior design. The hotel's interior features wood, Madagascan stone, onyx and marble.



Each detail, from light fixtures to furniture, was selected with care, and particular attention given to the illumination of the hotel and its environment. The premises, rooms and suites at Hotel Bellevue feature architectural lighting design by Dean Skira, nominated in the 'Best International Lighting Project' category of the prestigious LDA Lighting Design Awards. The Čikat Bay marine lighting project, *Meduza*, also won first prize at the prestigious International Lighting Design Prize-Codega competition in Venice in 2015.

Hotel Bellevue has 185 rooms and 21 suites, including the 185m<sup>2</sup> Presidential Suite with its 119m<sup>2</sup> terrace, and suites ranging from 46 to 113m<sup>2</sup>. Each has an unforgettable view, whether facing Čikat Bay with its crystal-clear seas, the century-old forest or the hotel's atrium, and suite terraces equipped with Jacuzzis. Hotel Bellevue's offer is completed by the Bellevue Spa Clinic - awarded the prestigious title of world's best new spa by Spafinder Wellness in 2015 - which gives guests the opportunity to enjoy the unique concept of a temple for body and soul. Hotel Bellevue also received the Condé Nast Johanssen's Award for Excellence 2018 in the Best Destination Spa category.

The Bellevue Spa Clinic is an extraordinary 2500sqm wellness sanctuary where guests can immerse themselves in integrative health programmes and benefit from the expertise of renowned global specialists and brands, from





French podiatrist Bastien Gonzalez to Forlle'd Japan, Pharmos Natur and Valmont. A serene vision of gleaming terrazzo floors and bright, translucent onyx partitions, this world-leading haven boasts exceptional facilities including:

- Seven treatment rooms and two Deluxe spa suites
- Aveda Hairlab by Ruza
- Medi Spa offering non-invasive medical aesthetic therapies including EXEMIA, CryoSauna, Oxygen and anti-ageing treatments, delivered by a team of resident aestheticians, doctors and dermatologists
- Marine Medical Centre offers a Dermatologist, Internal Medicine Doctor, TCM Doctor, a registered nurse and on call Radiologist and Cardiologist, offering full medical MOTs
- Spa & Relax zone with indoor and outdoor heated seawater pools, Finnish and bio soft saunas, steam bath, plunge pool, Experience showers, cutting-edge Diamond System chromotherapy waterbeds, heated stone beds and a reading corner
- Open air Cabana Spa garden with sauna, hot tub, plunge pool and pergola-shaded al fresco treatment areas
- Fitness centre with MATRIX equipment and indoor and outdoor studios
- Secluded spa terrace for post-treatment relaxation, featuring sunbeds and no fewer than five Jacuzzis

In addition, guests can also shop for designer clothes in the sophisticated BelleEpoque Store.

Another way in which Hotel Bellevue stands out amongst hotels across the Adriatic coast and its islands are its two unique charging stations for Tesla cars. Hotel Bellevue is listed on Tesla's maps showing the locations of Tesla charging stations, which contributes to raising awareness about the advantages of using electric cars and is an integral part of the Jadranka Group's philosophy on sustainable development.

The latest award for this first luxury hotel in Čikat Bay was nominated by guests who rated Hotel Bellevue as the best hotel in four categories on TripAdvisor. Bellevue was rated 1 of 5 best hotels in the category [Top 25 Luxury Hotels — Croatia](#) in 2019; [Top 25 Hotels – Croatia](#); and in the [Top 25 Hotels for Romance — Croatia](#).

For a premium gourmet experience, Hotel Bellevue's chefs prepare a selection of traditional dishes, with a touch of modern cuisine, and using only selected ingredients from suppliers across Croatia. Menus centre on fresh seasonal foods, prepared daily in a variety of creative ways for guests' enjoyment.

In the summer of 2018, *Matsunoki* became the first Japanese restaurant on the Croatian islands when it opened at Hotel Bellevue. Menus are based on Mediterranean ingredients from local organic farms, enabling guests to enjoy the freshest beef teriyaki, karrage chicken, maki sushi, matcha ice cream with a sweet paste made from adzuki beans, and sesame crumble, as well as other selected specialities, guaranteeing an extraordinary gourmet experience. The Mali Lošinj Tourist Board recognised *Matsunoki* with a special award in the category of 'Innovation' in tourism 2018.

*Matsunoki* also offers a selection of whiskeys by renowned Japanese distilleries such as Nikka Taketsuru, The Yamazaki, Hakushu and Hibiki, and a choice of sparkling and still sake wines and sake brandies. The sake wine offer was showcased in an inaugural Masterclass at Hotel Bellevue in June 2018, led by award-winning Austrian sommelier and sake educator, Suwi Zlatic, and the first Croatian-certified sake sommelier Ivan Jug. They





presented eight sake wines, ranging from those with calm and sparkling notes to the more complex aspects of long-lasting wine.

Hotel Bellevue also boasts a refreshing cocktail menu featuring nine original new signature cocktails for guests to savour, including Tropical Addict, Lošinj Gardens, It's Gin Time and Jaffa Zacapa. Along with these cocktails, the hotel bar *Alto Rosso* offers Pink Lee, Lošinj Goes To Japan, ELYX JULEP and ELYX La VIE cocktails, each representing an imaginative blend of local Lošinj flavours and liqueurs with different influences from around the world. As well as cocktails, guests can also enjoy Hennessy Richard, Hennessy Paradis and Louis XIII de Remy Martin cognac.

Hotel Bellevue is also an impressive and versatile venue for meetings, conferences and events. There is a large hall with a capacity of up to 360 seated, which can also be divided into three smaller halls and two additional conference rooms. Deluxe wedding packages are also available for those who wish to celebrate their marriage in beautiful style.







## Boutique Hotel Alhambra & Villa Augusta – Small Luxury Hotels of the World member



The opening of the five-star Boutique Hotel Alhambra & Villa Augusta completes the story of Čikat Bay. Incorporating a restored Austro-Hungarian villa originally built in 1912, Boutique Hotel Alhambra was designed by prominent Viennese architect Alfred Keller, who drew inspiration from Spanish architecture. Adjacent to Alhambra is Villa Augusta, another historic Austro-Hungarian villa originally built in 1908 in the Classicist style with Art Deco details. As part of the five-star Boutique Hotel Alhambra, Villa Augusta can be booked in its entirety, offering an ideal blend of private villa and hotel experience. The Villa's six suites and one bedroom provide an ideal flexible option for guests seeking a private villa-style experience with all the facilities of a world-class hotel.

Boutique Hotel Alhambra is a unique place which merges the spirit and exceptional luxury of its aristocratic heritage, with five-star customised service. During the course of reconstruction of the hotel, each piece of furniture was carefully selected; restored antique pieces, designer Louis Ghost Chairs and artisan wooden furniture are complemented by exclusive materials, such as Sartori carpets, brocade bed linen and Salvatore Ferragamo beauty products. Guests at Alhambra can enjoy 36 excellently equipped deluxe rooms and 15 suites named after Lošinj's prominent captains and meritorious visionaries.





Alongside extraordinary luxury, Boutique Hotel Alhambra stands out for its Wine & Dine offer and à la carte restaurant, *Alfred Keller*, which serves only the finest delicacies made from traditional ingredients such as olive oil, goat cheese, lamb, boškariin meat (native Istrian cattle), fresh fish and shellfish, and other delights from the Adriatic Sea. The *Alfred Keller* restaurant was awarded a two chef's hat rating by renowned French guide, Gault & Millau.

Talented head chef Melkior Bašić takes care of the unique gourmet journey in the *Alfred Keller* restaurant. Although young, Chef Bašić has acquired a wealth of career experience in 96 kitchens in Croatia and abroad, and specialises in using various techniques, such as minimal thermal processing of particular ingredients such as fish, lamb and venison from the island of Cres, in order to maintain their innate flavour quality, thereby achieving an almost perfect balance.

The hotel also includes a wine cellar that stocks over 400 exquisite international wines, and an archive of rare Croatian wines that guests can sample on wine evenings and exclusive oenological masterclasses with professional sommeliers, where leading domestic and foreign wine producers like Sassicaia, Opus One, Château Mouton Rothschild, Château Lafite Rothschild, Domaine Hugel and Krauthaker present exclusive and limited edition bottles.

Additionally, a special aspect of the wine offer of Boutique Hotel Alhambra is a selection of exceptional wines available by the glass, thanks to Coravin - one of the world's leading systems for pouring wine without opening the bottle. In addition to the rich and varied wine list, the hotel's exceptional drinks menu is completed with over 200 different types of spirits, cocktails and a unique water menu - including the exclusive and rare cognacs, Hennessy Richard, Hennessy Paradis and Louis XIII de Remy Martin, available at both Boutique Hotel Alhambra and Hotel Bellevue.

Boutique Hotel Alhambra, a Small Luxury Hotels of the World member, is one of only two Croatian members of [Virtuoso](#), the American network of leading tourist entities, and also one of five Croatian representatives of the [Traveller Made](#) community, which gathers consultants, managers and agencies. The service in Alhambra is fully customised and tailored to each guest, to give guests the possibility of absolute enjoyment during their vacation, which is designed according to their wishes and preferences. Guests have at their disposal a beach with accompanying facilities, lobby bar, luxurious wine cellar, library, jewelry shop and wonderfully equipped wellness oasis with indoor pool. Thanks to the carefully created spa offer, Cube Spa Alhambra received the award for the 'Best Luxury Boutique Spa' in Croatia, by the recognised global organisation, World Luxury Hotel Awards. Treatments at the Cube Spa Alhambra are designed to restore the balance between spirit and body, according to the individual needs of the guest. Available for revitalisation are a Finnish sauna, Mediterranean bath, experience showers, fitness, Pilates and personal trainers. For an effective and authentic spa experience, there is natural cosmetics brand Mirta, as well as the exclusive cosmetics brands Valmont, Forlle'd, Pharmos Natur, OPI and Kure Bazaar.







## Villa Hortensia



A beautifully restored residence dating back to the Austro-Hungarian *Belle Époque*, the five-star Villa Hortensia opened its doors in July 2015. Boasting an enviable seafront location and traditional architecture, this *Small Luxury Hotels – Private Residence* features 10 stylish en-suite bedrooms over three floors, beautifully appointed indoor and outdoor living spaces, designer décor, heated outdoor seawater pool and an outdoor whirlpool and massage area, all surrounded by landscaped gardens creating a fragrant ambiance.

## Villa Mirasol



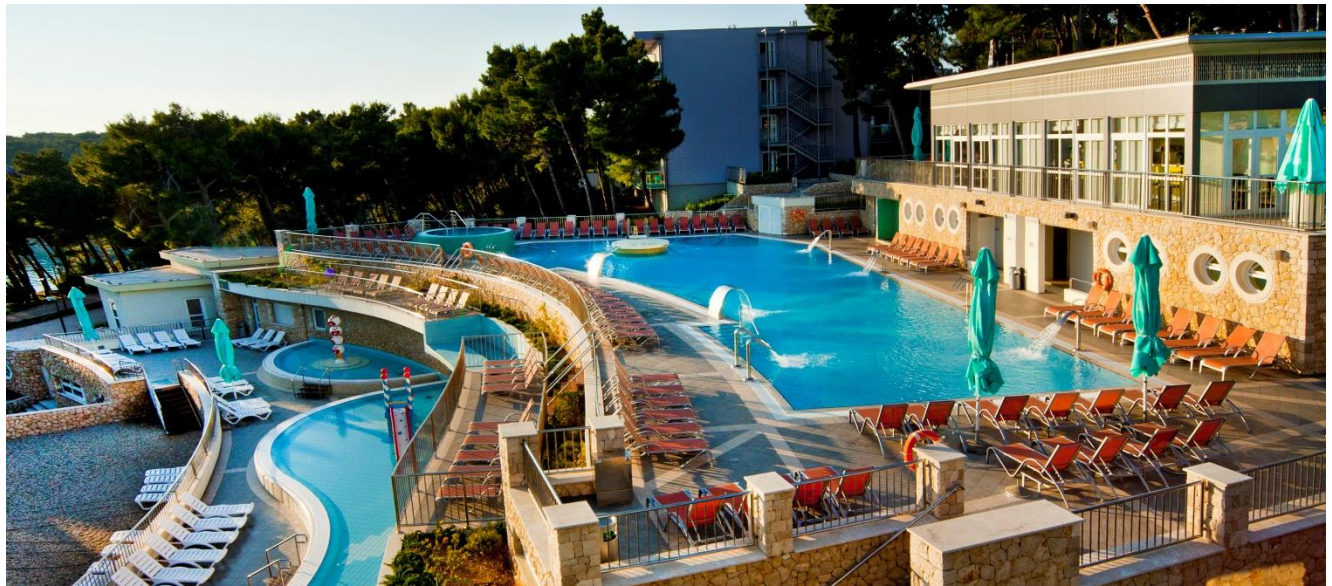
Set back amongst lush gardens a few steps from the turquoise waters of Čikat Bay, shaded by fragrant pine forest, Villa Mirasol offers sumptuous accommodation throughout its five bedrooms and a separate three-bedroom apartment, which can be booked individually or together as an exclusive buyout. Originally built in 1902 and restored in 2011, Villa Mirasol is an exquisite example of the charming Art Nouveau style and features a distinctive lookout tower, two terraces overlooking the bay and a carefully landscaped, spacious garden with a Jacuzzi. The airy and luxurious interiors are dominated by designer furniture aligned with impressive marble and wooden surfaces and eclectic original artwork. For additional entertainment, the villa also offers a private cinema hall, a library and a wellness area with saunas. Directly in front of the villas, guests will find a stretch of beach and private bathing decks reserved just for them – perfect for those looking to unwind and enjoy the beneficial effects of Lošinj's air, sea and nature.







## Improvement of the four-star offer– conference, vitality, family and gourmet tourism



In addition to developing the luxury tourism segment, investments have also focused on improving service and the four-star level offer. Hotel Aurora, Family Hotel Vespera and Vitality Hotel Punta, with their individual offers, are intended for a different market. **Family Hotel Vespera** is tailored to families with children; while



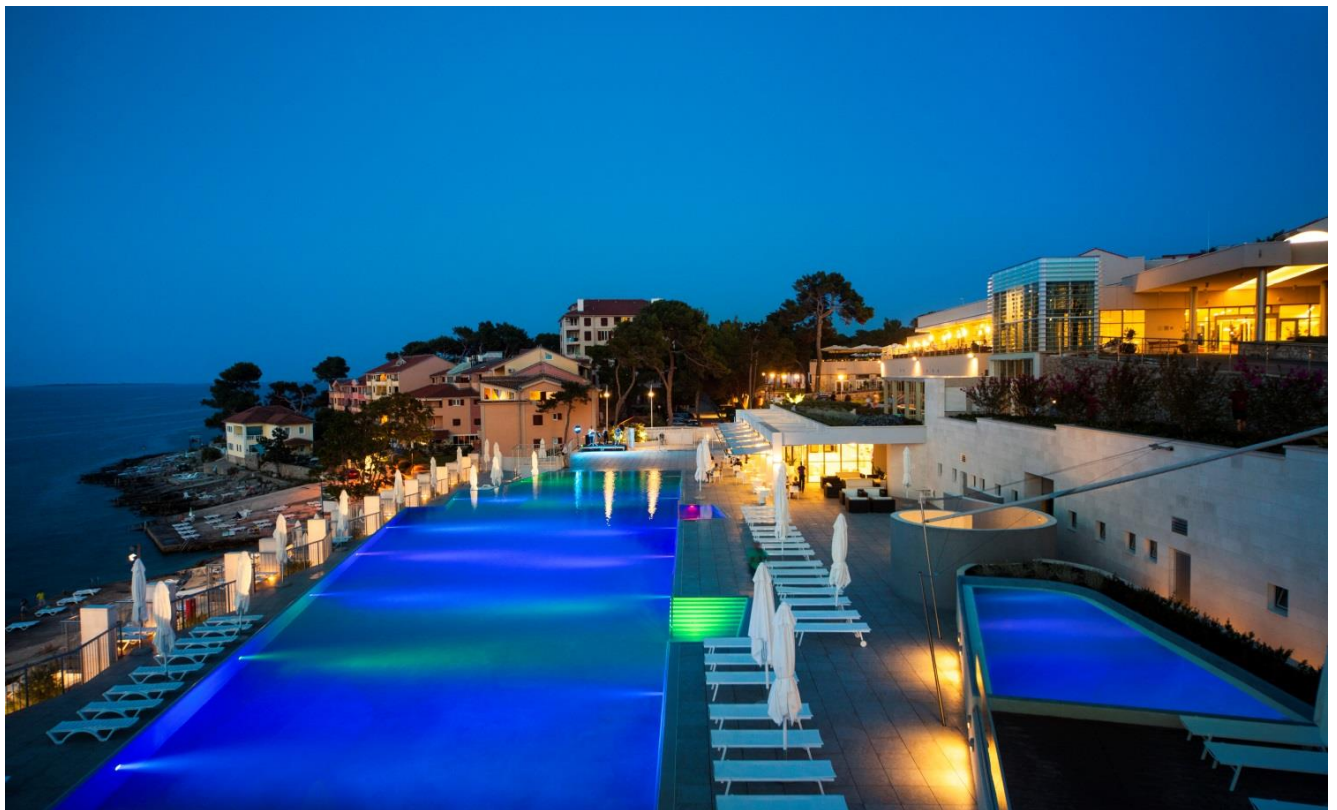
**Hotel Aurora** is positioned as a distinct wellness concept, inspired by the nature of the Cres-Lošinj archipelago, with unique treatments that include eco-certified oils and herbs and an expert team of therapists. Both hotels are







located in Sunčana bay, surrounded by a seaside promenade and boasting one of the most beautiful natural beaches in Mali Lošinj – Veli žal. For active holiday lovers, Sunčana bay - itself awarded the White Flag, the ecological symbol of clean water - boasts tennis courts, a multipurpose field for football, basketball, tennis and volleyball, beach volleyball court, bowling alley, mini golf and table tennis as well as a range of watersports. Recreation lovers will be thrilled with the hiking trails and footpaths, where they can enjoy walking or cycling, while the summer months in Sunčana Bay are perfect for water sports.



**Vitality Hotel Punta**, set in the picturesque town of Veli Lošinj, is ideal for guests looking for an active vacation with many attractions and a healthy diet. With Punta's vitality concept, it is possible to experience the highest level of harmony inspired by nature, through the specially designed gastronomic, relaxation and wellness offer. Guests staying in Vitality Hotel Punta's 319 rooms and 48 suites, can enjoy views of Velebit and the endless blue sea, sunbathing areas and the White Flag hotel beach. Furthermore, guests can consult with specialists in internal medicine and nutritionists, who will create a recommended diet and activity programme based on medical examinations and the guest's preferences and needs.

Since the island of Lošinj is a climatic resort due to its climate and vegetation, guests have at their disposal a pulmonary rehabilitation programme aimed at those with respiratory problems. Research has shown a significant improvement in spirometry results after 11 days, and especially after three weeks, spent on Lošinj. The benefits





of time spent in Lošinj's beautiful natural environment are further complemented by professionally run sports programmes. For example, in Vitality Hotel Punta, guests can enjoy outdoor fitness activities such as artificial stone climbing accompanied by instructors; cycling and walking on the hiking trails near the hotel; or tennis on one of 12 tennis courts.

The newly opened 5,000 sqm Vitality Fitness Centre is one of the largest fitness facilities in Croatia and offers a modern, airy space with plentiful natural light and spectacular view of the seas. The centre boasts an impressively designed gym with state-of-the-art Technogym equipment, cutting-edge cardio and isotonic equipment for aerobic and functional training, as well as Antigravity yoga hammocks and training supported and licensed by US-based Antigravity Fitness - a first for Croatia.

In addition, in 2014, Vitality Hotel Punta became the first hotel in Croatia to receive the prestigious EuropeSpa certificate awarded by the European Spa Association (ESPA), thereby confirming that Punta implements the highest international quality standards in wellness, spa and vitality services, and the international ECARF certificate, confirming that Vitality Hotel Punta's products and services are fully adapted to the needs of allergy-prone people. In 2017, Vitality Hotel Punta became the first hotel in the Adriatic to host the BOSK gluten free standard – the first Croatian gluten free certificate. In 2019, Vitality Hotel Punta was awarded the Run Friendly certificate, which means that all recreators and runners staying in Punta will find an ideal hotel experience fully adapted to their lifestyle.

Lošinj Hotels & Villas is renowned for its exceptional gourmet credentials, with an extensive portfolio of 11 restaurants and bars, including *Alfred Keller*, the acclaimed *Matsunoki*; *Punta*; *Veli žal*; *Levante*; *Čikat and Silver Bay*; *Lanterna Grill*; *Diana Steak House*; *Borik Mediterranean Bar*; *Kredo Bar*, and *Konoba Cigale*. All share a commitment to using top quality, fresh ingredients sources via an unprecedented network of local producers in Lošinj and Cres, as well as over 60 suppliers throughout Croatia. All are family farms that use eco-certified production methods, ensuring all the restaurants in the Lošinj Hotels & Villa' portfolio benefit from an unrivalled supply of the very best natural ingredients, while providing support to small Croatian entrepreneurs.

### Lošinj Hotels & Villas' awards and recognitions

Following its efforts to improve the overall service and accommodation offer and crucially the successful investment into Čikat Bay, Lošinj Hotels & Villas has received numerous awards and recognitions over the past few years. The portfolio has received more than 20 domestic, regional, and international professional awards and recognitions, including the Excellence Certificate awarded by the European Spa Association for the quality wellness and spa program of Hotel Bellevue; Vitality Hotel Punta and Hotel Aurora received the Meeting Star award for the best congress resort; the Condé Nast Johannsen's Award for Excellence in the Best Destination Spa category presented to Hotel Bellevue; the special jury award in the Innovative Spa & Health Resort Destination category; the international Darc Awards for the lighting project in Čikat Bay; and the Brand Leader Award 2016 for tremendous contribution to tourism market. The latest in this series of accolades was for Hotel Bellevue's Japanese restaurant *Matsunoki* which earned deserved recognition from the Tourist Board of Mali Lošinj in the category of Innovation in tourism in 2018.





A special place among these recognitions is reserved for TripAdvisor's Certificates of Excellence. Vitality Hotel Punta and Family Hotel Vespera have been perennial winners of the Certificate of Excellence from the world's largest tourist portal for travel planning and accommodation booking since 2013; the certificate was also regained by Hotel Aurora in 2017 after having been awarded for four consecutive years from 2012 to 2015. Thanks to the high quality of service as rated according to guest reviews Hotel Bellevue, Boutique Hotel Alhambra, and the Lanterna Grill restaurant were also among the winners of the 2017 Certificates of Excellence.

The list of awards also includes the World Luxury Hotel Awards 2016, in the Luxury Honeymoon Hotel category for Hotel Bellevue and in the Luxury Boutique Hotel category for Boutique Hotel Alhambra; and the prestigious Wellness Travel Award – Spafinder Wellness 365™ and a two-time annual TripAdvisor Travelers' Choice award for Boutique Hotel Alhambra. The latest recognition for Boutique Hotel Alhambra is the Meetings Star Award 2018, which has named Alhambra as the Best Boutique Meeting Hotel for 2018.

## Key projects

Improvement of the offer and services, creating additional facilities beyond hotels and thereby extending the tourist season are some of the Group's strategic goals. In order to allow the island of Lošinj to achieve a comparative advantage through its offer and distinguish itself among competitors, the realisation of several key projects is planned for the coming period, including: redevelopment of the promenade with new infrastructure in Čikat Bay; reconstruction of the Hotel Helios and surrounding villas; redevelopment and expansion of Mali Lošinj Airport; construction of a new eco golf resort; and the realisation of a new marina project.

## Expansion of Mali Lošinj Airport







The planned redevelopment and expansion of Mali Lošinj Airport will also contribute to the achievement of the Group's strategic goals and facilitate access to the destination for all visitors. The goal of reconstructing the existing airport in Mali Lošinj is to facilitate faster and easier year-round arrival of international guests, particularly those from key markets, to the Island of Lošinj, whose geographical position makes it a natural air transport destination. The project includes the expansion of the runway to 1800m and the construction of a new airport building, which will allow aircraft with the capacity of up to 180 passengers to land in Lošinj.

It should be emphasised that, as per the airport's current capacities, Lošinj Hotels & Villas offers air taxi services for its guests, using the Beechcraft King Air C90B aircraft, which can transport up to six passengers, and Piper and Cessna aircraft which can transport up to three passengers each. Flights can be arranged on request from domestic and foreign airports.

### Reconstruction of the Helios Resort

Upcoming plans also include the reconstruction and renovation of the existing Hotel Helios, located in the Čikat forest park. This is a hotel which was built in the 1960s and was one of the leading facilities of Lošinj's tourism back in the day. As well as the restoration of Hotel Helios to its former glory, construction will include the building of a resort which will, through its holistic vitality offer and the concept of coexistence with nature, offer a whole new dimension of vacation. In addition to the reconstruction of the hotel, the renovation of the surrounding elite villas is planned, which will also follow the holistic concept.

### Eco golf resort





The eco golf resort project at Matalda on the island of Cres will provide top-rate golf courses for guests staying in the existing hotels, as well as those staying on-site in the new resort. With a mild Mediterranean climate, golf can be played at Matalda throughout the year, which will ultimately create year-round employment for local residents. In addition to supporting year-round operations for the entire destination of Lošinj, the building of two 18-hole championship golf courses, designed by Ernie Els, will make it possible to host large, global golf tournaments. Construction with minimal impact on nature and the implementation of the strictest environmental protection measures will help make Matalda one of the most recognisable golf venues in the world, strengthening Lošinj's position on the global map of top tourism destinations.

### Realisation of a new marina

In addition to the above projects, the realisation of a new marina project and accompanying facilities in Mali Lošinj will bring completely new features to Lošinj's tourism proposition. The new marina will not only increase the number of berths, but the new facilities will make the island of Lošinj - which already enjoys an excellent geographical position in the northern part of the Adriatic - a must-visit destination for the international yachting community.
